- **Cabinetry:** For shelving, casing, and drawer bottoms, MultiPly offers the strength of thicker panels yet is lighter weight than comparable sized panels
- **Paneling:** The 3-ply 0.8mm and 3-ply 1.8mm thicknesses offer a veneering solution that is resistant to splitting
- **Furniture:** The 3-ply thicknesses is designed specifically to preform complex compound curves and bends
- **Doors:**  $\frac{3}{8}$ " MultiPly can be used for light-weight doors, and the 2.7mm is an ideal thickness for door skins.

Bamboo Revolution introduces MultiPly, a lightweight, multi-layered product designed to offer increased strength and stability. Bamboo veneer, commonly used in the fabrication of cabinets and furniture, is very fragile. By laminating multiple sheets of bamboo veneer to get variable thicknesses, MultiPly produces much less waste because it is less prone to splitting during manufacture and production.

MultiPly uses EPI adhesives, a 100% formaldehyde-free adhesive that is extremely water resistant, even dishwasher safe.
